Fees

*Student and visitor need to be the member of Aikikai Foundation. (Registration Fee: 8,400yen)

Monthly Fee (Include Sunday class) Adults 5,000yen Children 2,000yen

Sunday Class Monthly Fee 2,000 yen

Visitor Practice Fee 1-10 days-----500yen/day 11days-1month---5,000yen

* We charge the visitor practice fee end of each month. So if you practice from 5/25 to 6/7, it will be 7,000 yen when you leave dojo.

Example (May 7 days =3,500 yen, June 7 days =3,500 yen)

Accommodations

1,000yen per day (Meals not included) * Include Bedclothes charge, Lighting and Heating expenses.

Practice Schedule

Monday - Saturday 19:00 - 20:00 Sunday 10:00 -11:00 * National Holidays and any particular days Dojo decides are closed.

For Visitor

If you are not the member of Aikikai Foundation, need to apply for the registration. (Registration Fee: 8,400yen)

Lesson Fee 1- 10 days ------500yen/day 11 days - 1month---5,000yen If you will stay at dojo, the accommodation fee is 1,000yen per day. Meals excluded.

Example 8-day stay (500yen + 1,000yen) x 8-day = 12,000yen 20-day stay 5,000yen + (1,000yen x 20-day) = 25,000yen

Regulations for Staying at the Ibaraki Branch Dojo

(Aikikai Foundation Ibaraki Branch Dojo)

The Ibaraki Branch Dojo was built by the founder of aikido, Ueshiba Morihei O-Sensei, in 1945. It is important as the final place in which O-Sensei underwent training and as the dojo in which present day aikido was brought to completion.

Today the dojo in not preserved purely as a memorial. Its continued operation is specially granted under the understanding of the 3rd Doshu, Ueshiba Moriteru Sensei. Therefore, those who would like to practise here should not treat it just as a place to stay and train, but should seek to experience the spirit of the Founder.

Those wishing to stay and train here must adhere to the following regulations:

- * Those wishing to stay and train must be Aikikai members.
- * The fees for training and accommodation must be paid in advance.
- 1.Do not touch any important materials at the jinja and dojo.
- 2. Conserve electricity and water.
- 3. Implement a cleaning regime for the:
- (1) dojo, Aikijinja and its precincts
- (2) front of the dojo and the car park
- (3) path from the dojo to the jinja
- (4) dormitory, kitchen/dining-room, bathroom and toilets
- 4. Keep tidy and in good order:
- (1) the dormitory (take responsibility for your valuables)
- (2) your bedding and personal effects on waking
- (3) the refrigerator (throw out unwanted items)

5. Pay careful attention to the following fire prevention points:

- (1) no smoking in the dojo or dormitory
- (2) check the gas cook-top, heaters and oil-heater for the bath
- (3) check electrical power-points and plugs
- (4) manage carefully the burning of dead leaves etc. outside.

6. Sort rubbish

(1) Seperate rubbish into combustibles, cans and bottles, and plastic bottles

7. Other

Any inappropriate sexual activity will result in immediate expulsion.

There will be no refund of fees paid.
